This letter is regarding the Grade 9 Provincial Achievement Tests scheduled in January, 2020. Your child will be writing two Provincial Achievement Tests – one per core subject enrolled in this semester. The Language Arts and Math PAT's both consist of a Part A and Part B exam and will be written on separate days. The Math Part B will be written on January 23rd and Part A on January 29th. The Language Arts Part A will be written on January 16th and Part B on January 24th.

Included with this letter is a schedule for all PAT exams, which details for you the dates and start times, materials needed for each exam, as well as attendance expectations for each exam day.

In order to encourage all students to put forth their best effort on the exams, our school has a policy that all students must remain in the exam room each day until 10:33 a.m. Because the Math Part A exam (Jan. 29th) is a shorter exam, the students must remain in the exam room until 9:45 am. Please remind your child to bring something to occupy themselves quietly at their writing station, such as a book or magazine if they complete the test early. Personal devices will not be permitted in the exam room.

Please note that <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>January 22nd</u> will be a regular school day with regular scheduled classes. Also note that the last PAT exam is Wednesday, January 29th and therefore marks the completion of the grade 9 core classes for the first semester. As a result, the grade 9 students will not have school on January 30th and 31st. Monday, February 3rd is the first school day of the second semester and regular classes will resume.
