

How to Apply for the Rutherford Scholarship

When do I apply?

- **After** you have received your completed high school transcripts and have enrolled in post secondary.
- Once submitted, it takes one month for student aide to complete the process.

What do I need?

- Social Insurance Number (SIN)
 - Your SIN will be validated with the Government of Canada before your application is reviewed
- Alberta Student Number (ASN)
 - Your ASN can be found on your Alberta Transcript of High School Achievement
- School Information
 - Post-secondary school you are going to attend
 - Start date
 - High School you attended

How do I Apply?

- Log into your [MyAlberta Digital ID](#)
 - Alberta Student Aide accounts are accessed through this account
- If it asks for your SIN, enter it.
 - If not, Do the following
 - Click “available services” in top menu bar
 - Scroll down and click Alberta Student Aid link
 - Click “applying for the first time - start here” - then “apply now”
 - Enter SIN
- Once logged into your Alberta Student Aid account, choose the Alexander Rutherford High School Achievement Scholarship in the Apply section.
