It is intended for a student who goes out of their way to support and uplift others, whether through acts of service, mentorship, or simply being a positive influence in the lives of those around them. This student leads by example, showing empathy and a willingness to help without expecting anything in return. Additionally, the scholarship is designed to assist a student who may face financial challenges in pursuing higher education, ensuring that their hard work, good character, and aspirations are supported as they take the next step in their academic journey.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Graduating student planning to attend a university or college
- Demonstrates good character, kindness, and a positive impact on others
- Financial need
- Involvement in extracurricular/community activities
- In good academic standing in high school

Application Requirements

- A short essay (eg. 500 words) on how you have made a positive impact on the school or community
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, mentor, or community leader
- Conditional acceptance letter for post secondary (or a written explanation of plans for higher education)
